
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AROUND THE WORLD, TRAVEL - MARCH 20, 2019 - 11 COMMENTS

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
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
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
OUR STAY AT RIAD FES

We flew into Casablanca airport, so the drive up to Fes took around 3 hours. By the time we got there and checked in, we had been traveling for over 50 hours and...you could tell. We were exhausted despite our best efforts of sleeping on the plane.






At check-in, we were given mint tea and refreshing towels that sprouted to life when dipped in rose water – so cool! We were also greeted by the general manager and given a tour of the grounds. Riad Fes offers a spa, gym, several lounges, bar and restaurant.




Riad Fes originally belonged to a family of merchants and served as the family home. Since, the architect who owns the property has acquired the five surrounding buildings and created a larger hotel property for guests.



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Walking into Riad Fes, the first thing you notice is the attention to detail in the architecture. Every piece of tile was hand laid when it was originally done. When contractors came in to add modern amenities, the tiles were lifted up, numbered and relaid by hand to maintain has much original infrastructure as possible.









During our stay, Dane enjoyed a massage at the spa and he said it was very relaxing. They had tons of mini couches in the spa area with these gorgeous throws!







We loved being the first at breakfast every morning (it starts at 7AM and the buffet is amazing), followed by walking to the rooftop terrace to watch the sun come up over the Medina.


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

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




We booked our stay at Riad Fes through American Express' hotel concierge service (for platinum members, which came with a \$100 spa credit, free breakfast each morning, an early check-in and a premium upgrade. Because of this, we were given a the beautiful Ambassador's Suite, which is a ground-level suite with a garden view and private terrace.



The room was huge and more than we needed, but admittedly, it was really nice to relax in after so much travel.








in not mentioning that the smell in the main reception area is intoxicating!















We fell in love with the beautiful city of Fes and would definitely return to Riad Fes if we got the chance!
